Dream of the Red Chamber Research Collection

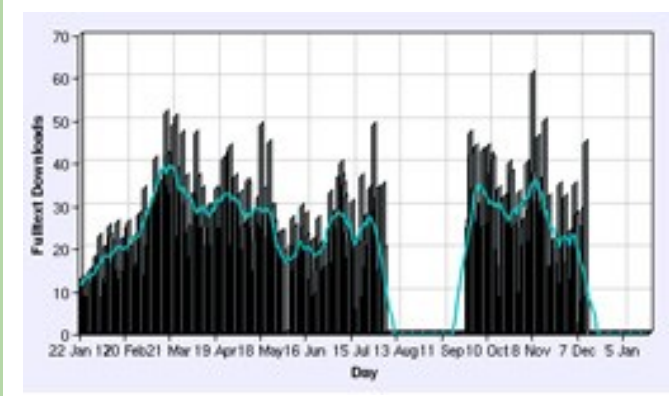

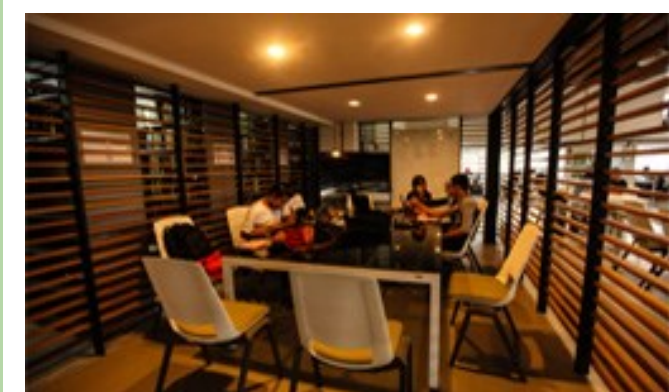
